During the guided walking tour passengers will enjoy some breathtaking views over marine caves, while they discover the picturesque little streets of the old center, adorned with flowers and you could taste the famous ice cream. In the heart of Apulia, the Itria valley (is a charming blend of rolling hills and valleys, populated by trulli and farmsteads, one of the most beautiful landscapes in Apulia or anywhere in Italy. A unique place where towns such as Alberobello (UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE), Martina Franca and Ostuni provide impressive images, evoking the true essence of this wonderful region. The trulli, limestone dwellings found in the southern region of Puglia, are remarkable examples of drywall (mortarless) construction, a prehistoric building technique still in use in this region. The trulli are made of roughly worked limestone boulders collected from neighbouring fields.
