for Teaching Activities from Partner Institutions in the People's Republic of China
and Vietnam within the framework of the NRRP Project
TNE23-00019 – LEGO, CUP H71124000300002

1. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

This initiative is promoted and implemented by the Ministry of University and Research - **MUR** within the framework of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan - **NRRP**, with the aim of developing and enhancing Transnational Education - **TNE** systems. It is funded by the European Union **NextGenerationEU** under NRRP **Mission 4** “Education and Research” – **Component 1** “Enhancement of education services: from early childhood education to university, from research to business” – **Investment 3.4** “Higher education and advanced skills” – **T4** “Transnational Education Initiatives” – **CUP H71124000300002**. The **Polytechnic University of Bari – Italy** implements the initiative through the publication of mobility programmes and related funding opportunities during the first semester of the Academic Year 2025/2026. Within this framework and in line with the **LEGO Project TNE23-00019 “Italy–East Asia Cooperation: from Local Expertise to a Global Outlook”**, the overarching objective is to strengthen structured academic cooperation and mobility between Italian Higher Education Institutions and Partner Universities in East Asia. The project promotes the exchange of best practices, the progressive alignment of institutional procedures with the standards of the European Higher Education Area - EHEA and the integration of principles of global cooperation, community engagement and sustainability.

Accordingly, the activities relevant to this mobility OPEN CALL fall under:

- **Internationalisation** – expand and strengthen partnerships with universities in East Asia through joint teaching activities and double degree programmes
- **Innovative Learning** – develop and pilot hybrid and collaborative teaching methods that overcome cultural barriers
- **Research and Advanced Skills** – promote joint doctoral programmes and scientific training focused on the digital and green transitions
- **Social Inclusion and Equal Opportunities** – ensure access to mobility for underrepresented groups and promote gender equality

The mobility activities carried out under this OPEN CALL shall correspond, through their activities, to the objectives of the following Work Packages:

- **WP5 – Cross-cutting Activities: Science and Technology for Sustainability:** defines and enhances cross-cutting, innovative and extracurricular activities within the scientific thematic macro-area, with a strong focus on sustainability and climate change mitigation
- **WP6 – Cross-cutting Activities: Management and Economics for Society:** defines and enhances cross-cutting, innovative and extracurricular activities within the economic and managerial thematic macro-area, with a focus on the territorial dimension and on relations between Italian and Asian businesses
- **WP7 – Enhancing Double and Joint Degrees:** defines cross-cutting activities across the partnership aimed at pursuing the strategic objective of establishing new agreements for double and joint degrees with Asian partners

All mobility activities must be completed no later than **May 20th 2026**

2. AVAILABLE POSITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This Open Call is addressed to Academic and Research Staff, both permanent and contract-based, from the following Partner Institutions:

3. FINANCIAL COVERAGE AND REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURES

A mobility grant is provided for each participant under the **NRRP Project TNE23-00059 – HEALTH-CONNECT CUP F91B24000320006** to cover board costs, accommodation and travel incurred during the mobility period. More specifically, each visiting member of Academic and Research Staff will be provided with hotel accommodation on a half-board basis i.e., breakfast and dinner while travel costs i.e., round-trip airfare and airport-city transfers will be reimbursed, subject to the submission of supporting documents, **up to the maximum amount specified in the table below:**

Travel costs will be **reimbursed on the basis of eligible costs**, subject to the submission of supporting documents and up to the maximum amount specified in the table above. Any costs exceeding this amount shall be borne entirely by the staff member. The procedures for reporting and payment, as well as all other conditions of participation, will be specified in the Mobility Contract signed between the staff member and the **Polytechnic University of Bari – Italy** at the start of the mobility period.

To request reimbursement of travel costs, selected Academic and Research Staff must submit the following documentation by the end of the mobility period to: tne-arcod@poliba.it

- copy of the purchased airfare
- copies of all eligible costs i.e., taxis

Any costs exceeding the maximum amount specified **shall remain entirely at the expense of the staff member**. Each selected member of Academic and Research Staff participating in the mobility programme **shall also be solely responsible for covering the following costs**:

- **travel and health insurance** valid for the entire mobility period
- any additional costs, including fees for sports activities or other optional services

4. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Academic and Research Staff from Partner Institutions shall express their interest in participating in the mobility for teaching and academic activities by completing the application form attached to this **OPEN CALL Annex A – Mobility Application Form** also attaching a **short CV** to the application and submitting both documents by email to tne-arcod@poliba.it no later than **April 19th 2026 at 12:00 (CEST/UTC+1)**. Should the number of applications exceed the number of available positions for each Partner Institution, admission shall be subject to the availability of funds and the consistency of the proposed activity programme with the objectives of the project.

5. OBLIGATIONS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE AWARD OF GRANTS AND REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS

Prior to arrival - the staff member shall agree with the **host Partner Institution** on the mobility programme and dates which shall be formalised in the **Staff Mobility Contract**.

Upon arrival - the staff member **shall sign** the Mobility Contract with the **Polytechnic University of Bari – Italy**.

At the end of the mobility period - please note that the disbursement of financial contributions is strictly subject to the submission of the following documentation:

- certificate of completion of the planned activities, indicating the start and end dates of the mobility period, signed by the scientific coordinator of the host Partner Institution
- report on the activities carried out, demonstrating their consistency with the objectives of the programme (Work Package 3 – Health and Inhabiting and Work Package 6 – Health and Development)

The report may include:

- slides, presentations and visual teaching materials
- documentation of field activities
- outputs of intensive activities (workshops, practical sessions, etc.)
- any other material related to the activities carried out

The above documentation must be submitted at the end of the mobility period to the following address: tne-arcod@poliba.it
